In the Orthodox Divine Liturgy, the Nicene Creed is recited immediately before the eucharistic prayer. It is preceded by a diaconal proclamation, "The doors, the doors, in wisdom let us attend." This is in origin a command to close the church doors in order to exclude those not yet baptised. But Metropolitan Anthony cites Maximus the Confessor's comment that in preparing to celebrate the eucharist we must close the doors of history and enter into the age to come.
